The site is located in the province of Mediouna in Grand Casablanca region where a new waste water treatment plant has been inaugurated shortly ago. This development opens the possibility to use treated waste water for the irrigation of agricultural land in Mediouna. Therefore the aim of the Summer School is to propose creative solutions and approaches for multifunctional landscapes that would ensure a sustainable future development for Mediouna.
